<p>\$65/YR</p>	<p>All registered adult volunteers in unit and non-unit positions. (Volunteers with multiple registrations will continue to pay for only one position).</p>
<p>\$30/YR</p>	<p>Scoutreach participants in kindergarten through age 20.</p>
<p>\$25/YR</p>	<p>This fee is for Merit Badge Counselors who are not already registered volunteers.</p> <p><small>Merit badge counselors who are not also registered in a unit position are not allowed to attend overnight Scouting activities/events.</small></p>

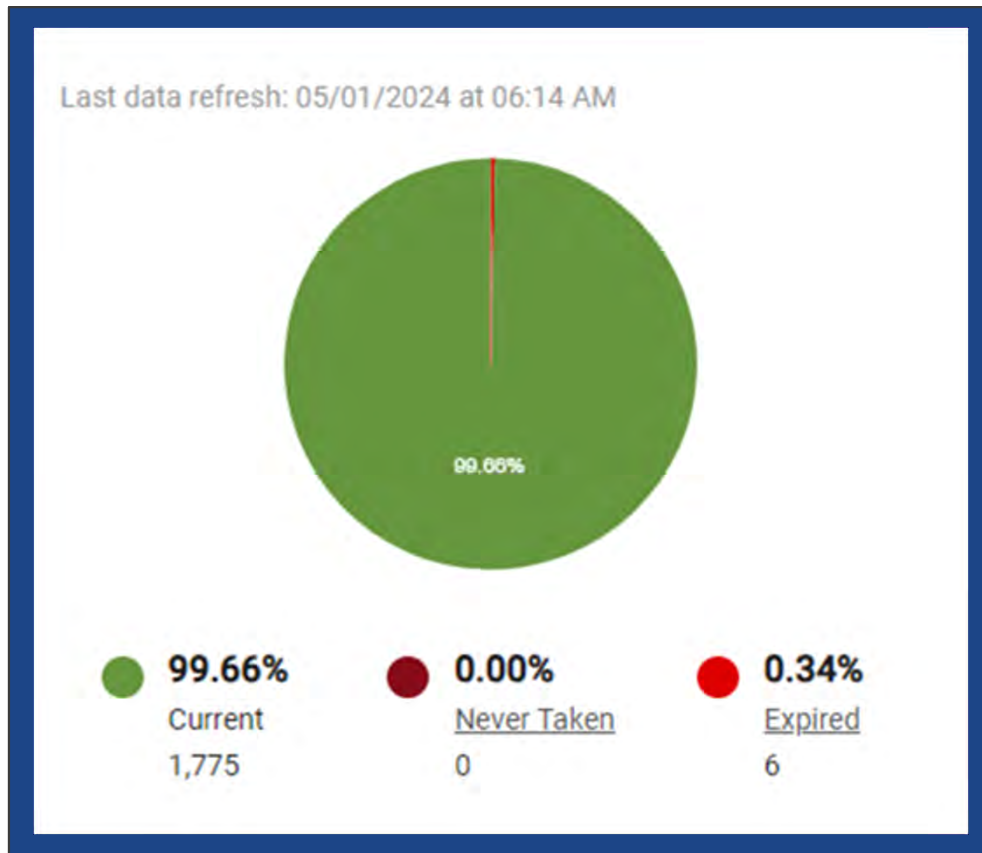

- ⌘ Establish a way to track AHMR status - a Google Sheet can be used for easy reference*. You can capture
 - ✦ Name
 - ✦ Health form status (Current, Not Current, Missing)
 - ✦ Parts collected (A/B or A/B/C)
 - ✦ Expiration date



*Note due to it containing Personal Information (PI) and Personal Health Information (PHI), **AHMRs are NOT to be digitized, scanned, sent by email, or stored electronically by unit leaders.**

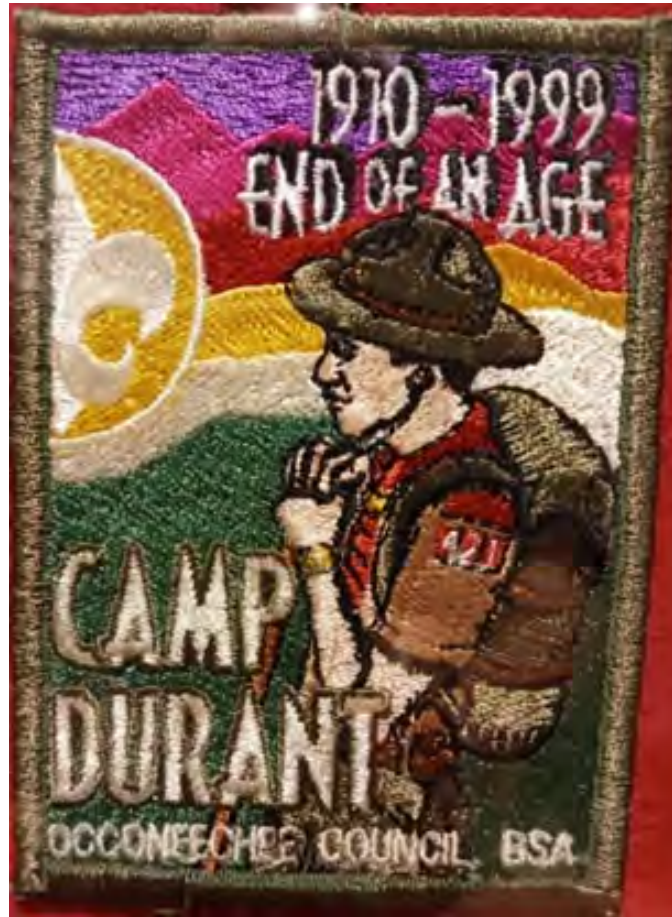

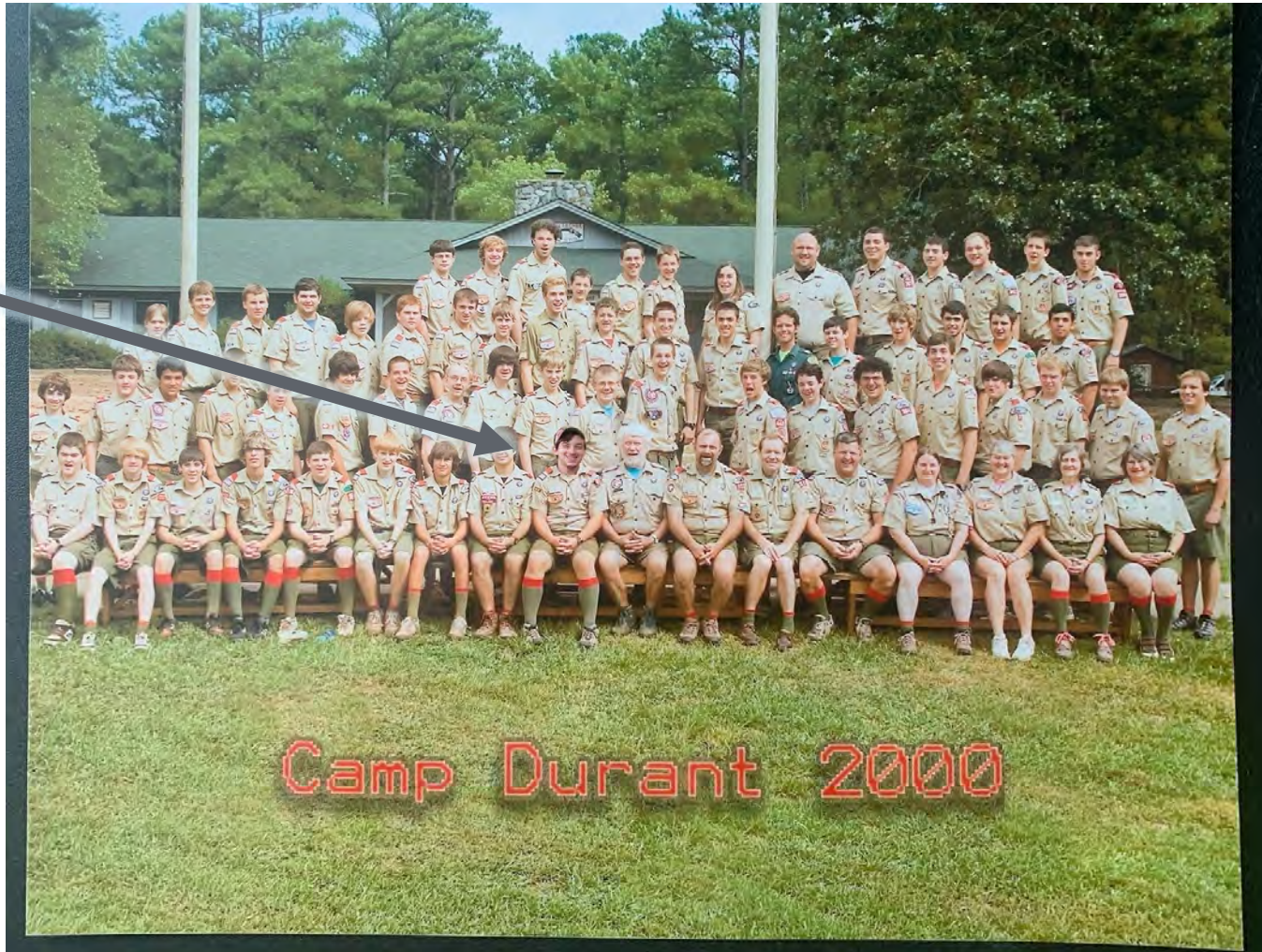
