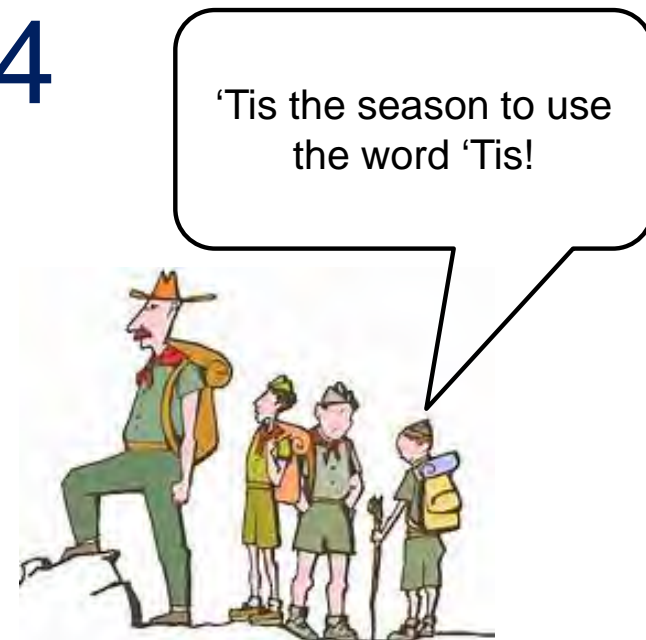

# Council Professional Updates

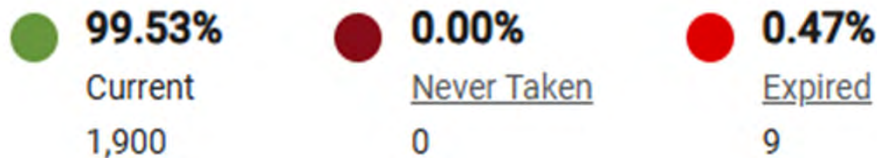
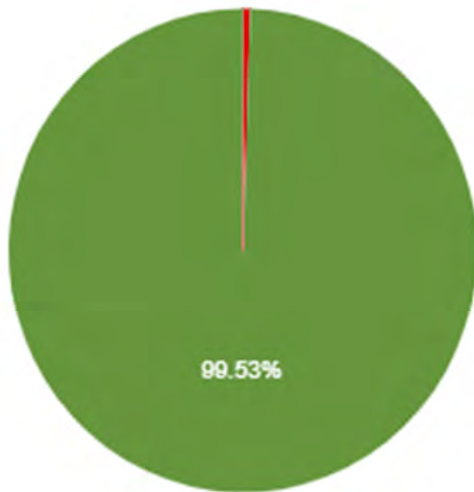
- January 11<sup>th</sup>: Cardinal Annual Business Meeting from 8:30 a.m. to noon.


## YPT Compliance Monitoring Process

- Unit Notification
  - List of expired participants shared with District Commissioner
  - District Commissioner shares with Unit Commissioner
  - Unit Commissioner shares with unit Key 3

# Safety Moment: Food Safety



Keep your meals and your Scouts safe while participating in hikes, campouts, and other outdoor activities with careful menu planning and by following safe food handling practices

## Keep it **COLD**

- Start with perishable foods chilled or frozen
- Use plenty of ice, frozen gel packs, or frozen juice boxes

## Keep it **CLEAN**

- Wash/clean hands
- Wash fruits and vegetables
- Avoid cross-contamination
- Use only a clean water source

## **COOK** it thoroughly

- Remember many Scouts are cooking on their own for the first time.
- Use a meat thermometer if you can
